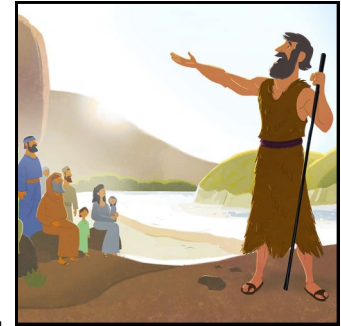
We give a warm welcome to Rev Terry Roberts who will lead our services this morning.

Trinity 6. 11th July 2021

In our Gospel Reading today, from Mark 6 v 14 – 29, we find that the central character is John the Baptist, who has been part of the story of Jesus from the very beginning. John's story begins even before his birth leaping in His mothers' womb when Mary visits Elizabeth, his mother, to share the news of the Annunciation and the Good News of the anticipated birth of Christ.

The Good News of Jesus Christ is told in all four of our Gospels as beginning with John as Christ's

forerunner. He is seen to have a predestined role similar to the Old Testament prophets particularly in encouraging the people of God to live lives worthy of their calling in anticipation of the coming of the Messiah. I'm sure that we all have a picture of John the Baptist as being dressed in animal skins and eating locusts and honey! but he came and called people to repent, to renounce their ways and prepare for the coming of Christ.
